

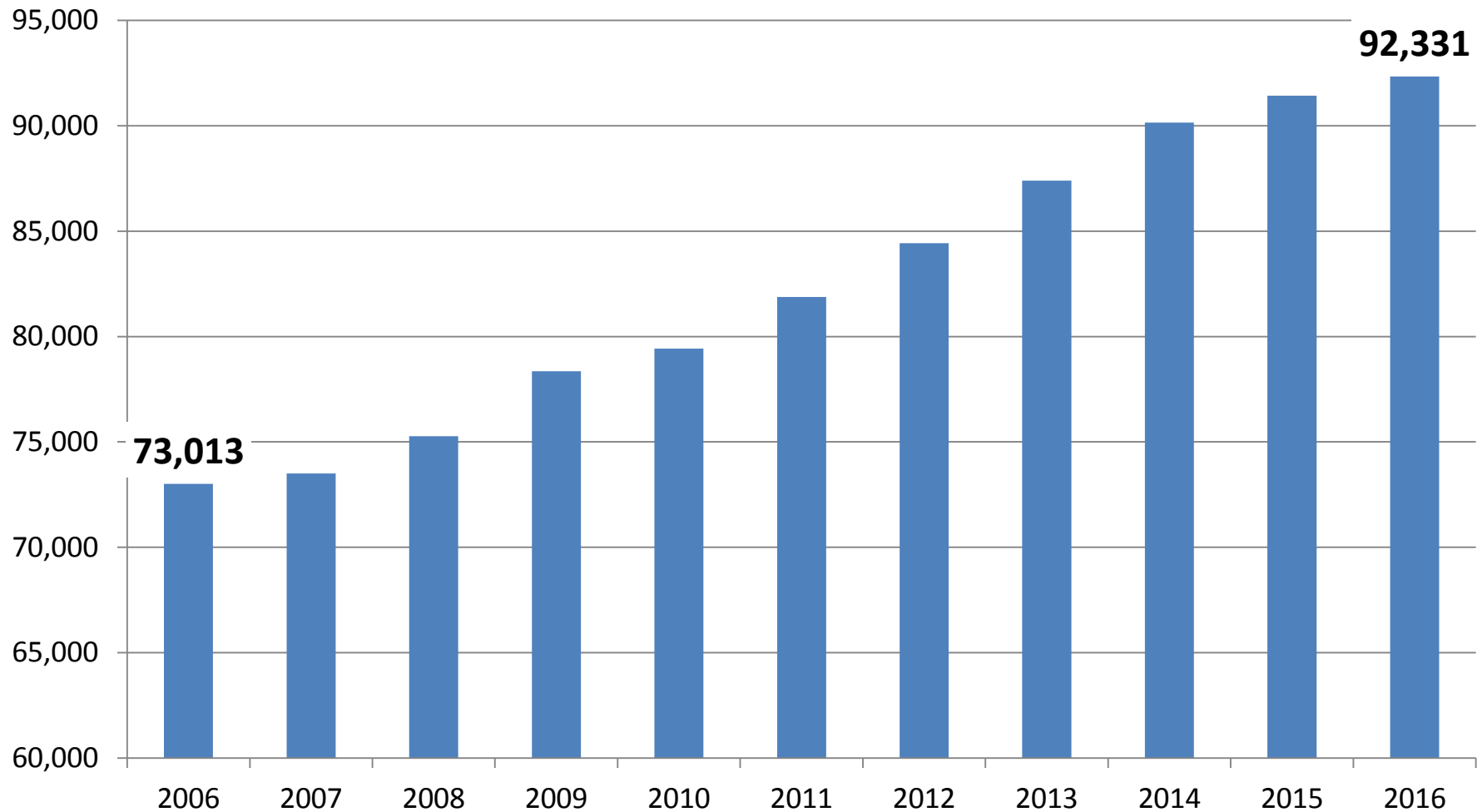

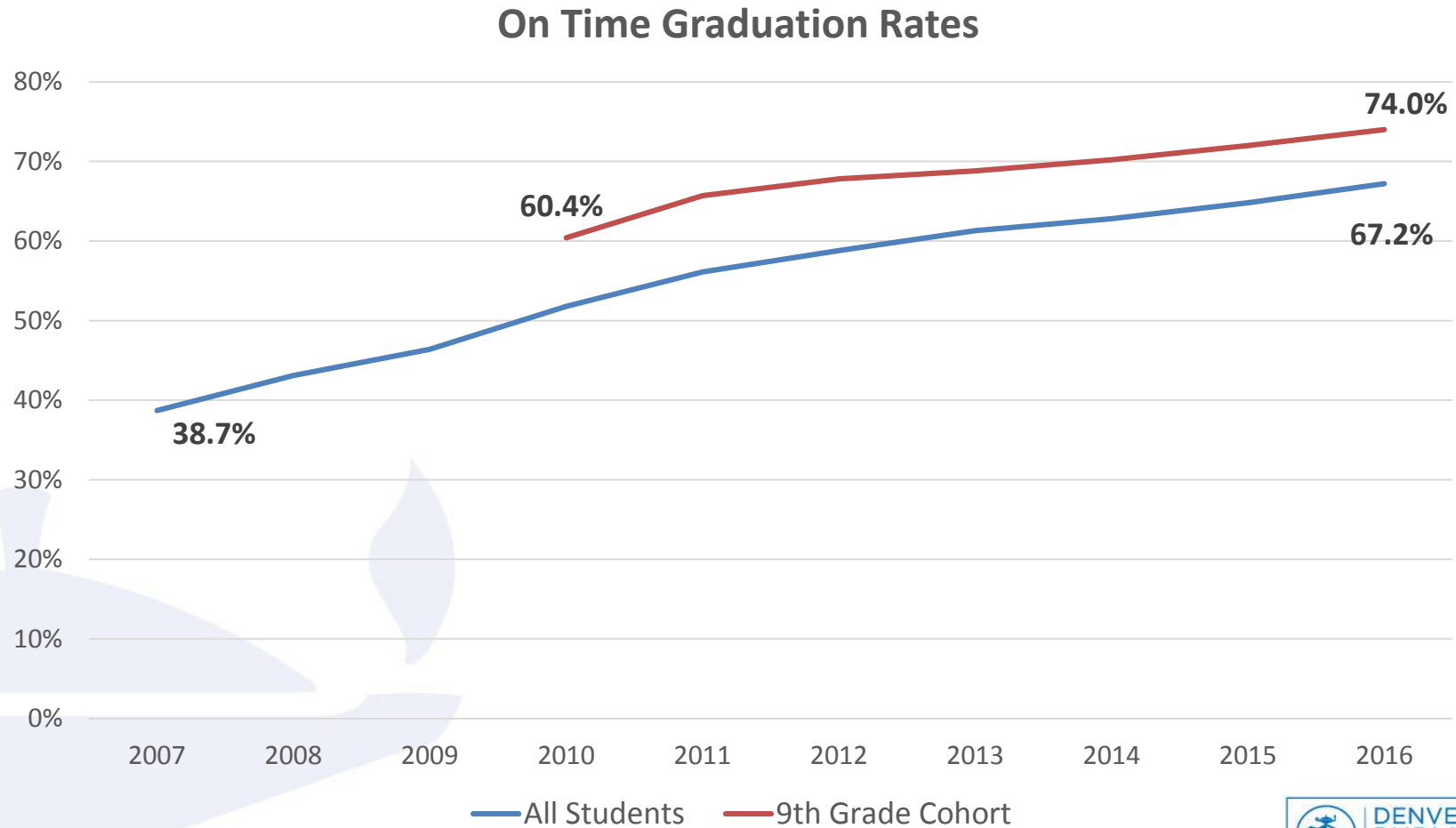

# DPS Has Been the Fastest Growing Urban School District in the Country

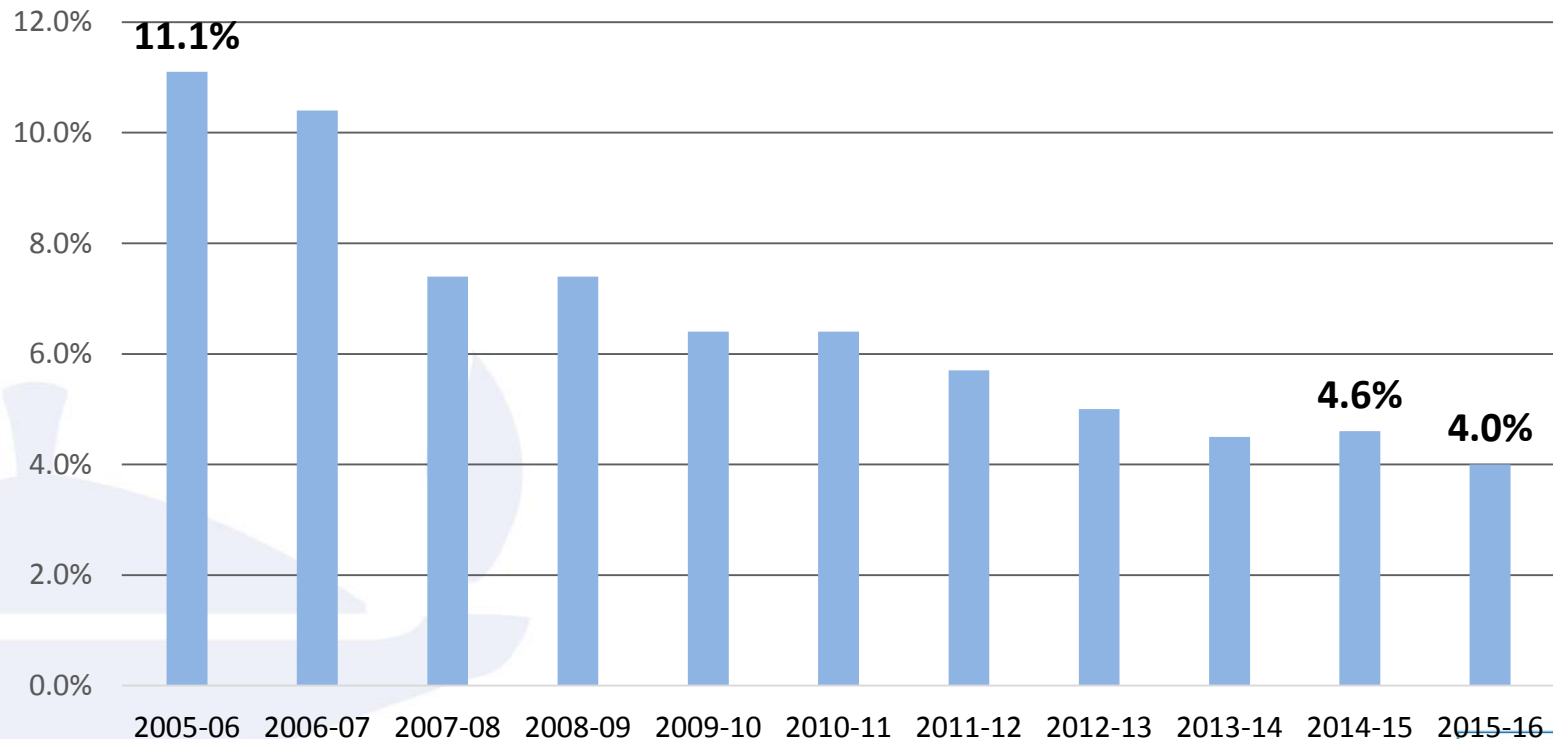


# On-Time Graduation Rates Continue to Increase



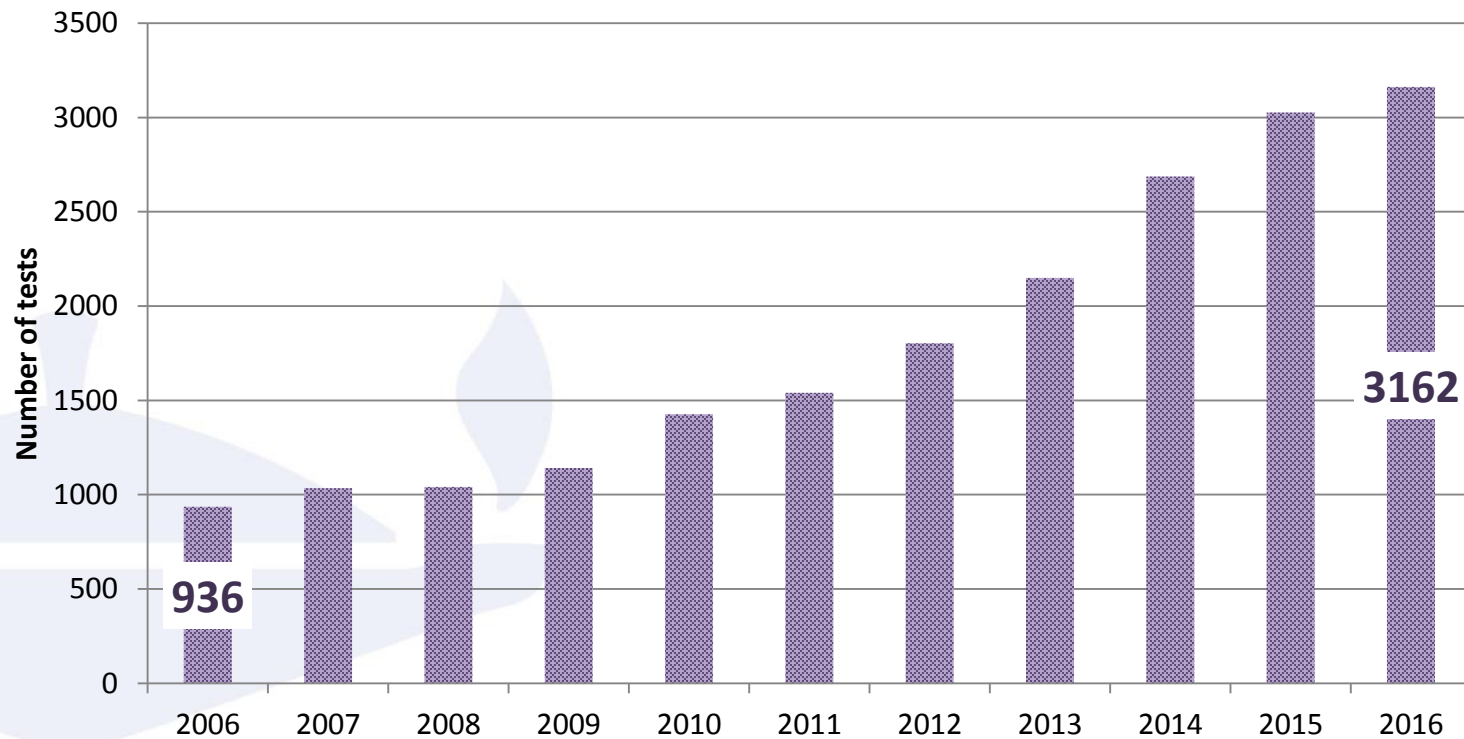
# Dropout Rate Decreased to 4 Percent; This Equates to 131 Fewer Dropouts Compared to 2014-15

**DPS Dropout Rate**



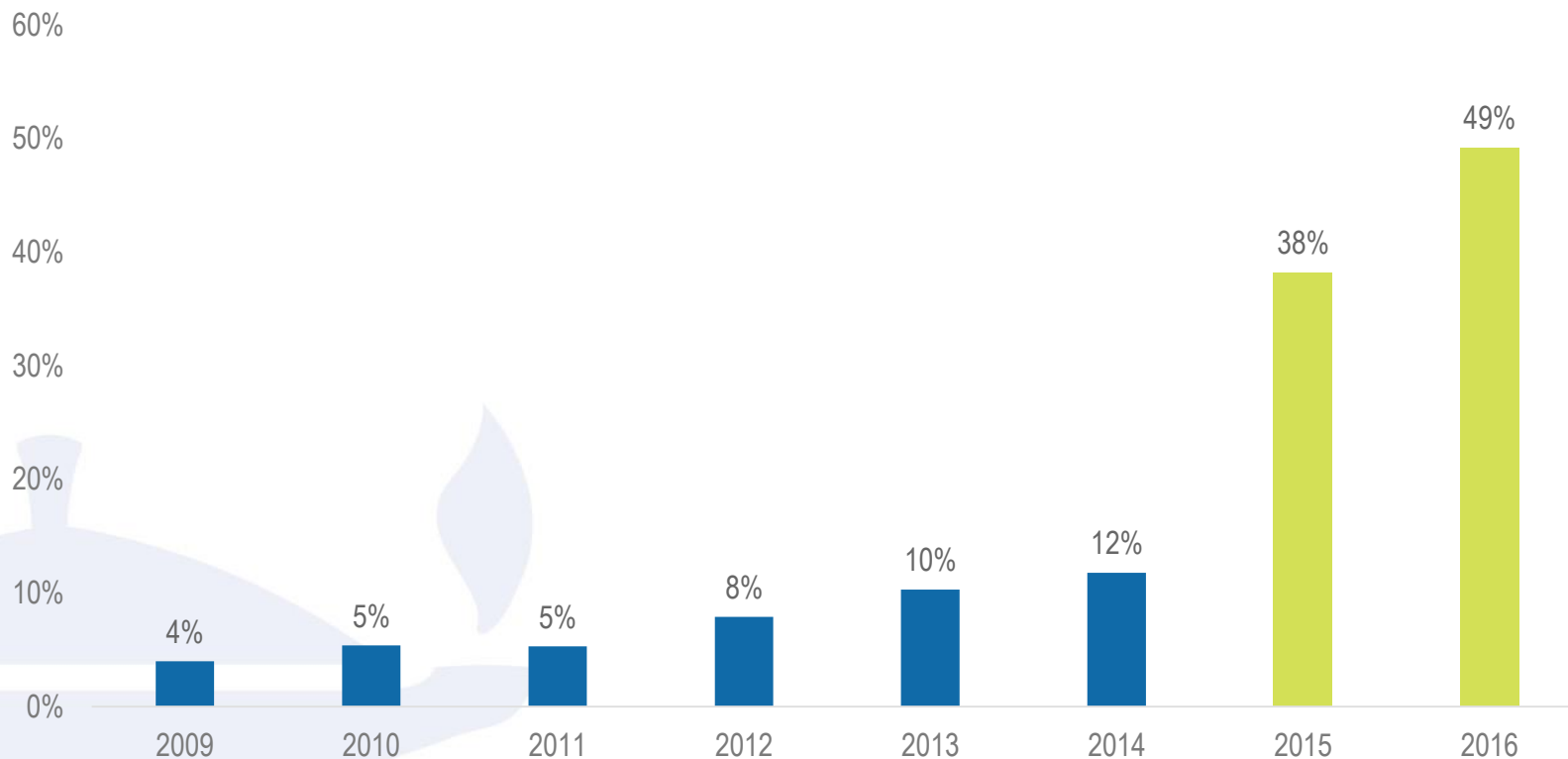
# DPS Students Continue to Make Gains on College Readiness Indicators, More Than Tripling the Number of AP Tests Passed
